Important Questions	Answers	Why This Matters:
What is the overall <u>Deductible</u> ?	\$500 person/\$1,000 family	Generally, you must pay all of the costs from <u>Provider</u> s up to the <u>Deductible</u> amount before this <u>Plan</u> begins to pay. If you have other family members on the <u>Plan</u> , each family member must meet their own individual <u>Deductible</u> until the total amount of <u>Deductible</u> expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family <u>Deductible</u> .
Are there services covered before you meet your <u>Deductible</u> ?	Yes. Pharmacy, services that require <u>Copays</u> , immunizations or <u>In-Network</u> hospice care and <u>Preventive Care</u> are covered before you meet your <u>Deductible</u> .	This <u>Plan</u> covers some items and services even if you haven't yet met the <u>Deductible</u> amount. But a <u>Copayment</u> or <u>Cost</u> <u>Sharing</u> may apply. For example, this <u>Plan</u> covers certain <u>Preventive Services</u> without <u>Cost Sharing</u> and before you meet your <u>Deductible</u> . What is the <u>Out-of-pocket</u> <u>Limit</u> for this <u>Plan</u> ? What is not included in the <u>Out-of-pocket Limit</u> ?	Contributions, <u>Balance-Billing</u> charges and health care this <u>Plan</u> doesn't cover.	Even though you pay these expenses, they don't count toward the <u>Out-of-pocket Limit</u> .

Does this plan provide Minimum Essential Coverage? Yes.

<u>Minimum Essential Coverage</u> generally includes <u>plans</u>, <u>health insurance</u> available through the <u>Marketplace</u> or other individual market policies, Medicare, Medicaid, CHIP, TRICARE, and certain other coverage. If you are eligible for certain types of <u>Minimum Essential Coverage</u>, you may not be eligible for the <u>premium tax credit</u>.

Does this plan meet the Minimum Value Standards? Yes.

If your plan doesn't meet the Minimum Value Standards, you may be eligible for a premium tax credit to help you pay for a plan through the Marketplace.
